Drop-off / Pick-up Reminders:

We have a detailed list of our drop-off / pick-up procedures published within our Handbook, but I wanted to highlight a couple items specifically:

- 1) Please do not leave your car unattended at the drop-off / pick-up curb in front of school
- 2) The right lane is for drop-off / pick-up, the left lane is for driving through to park at a designated parking spot please do not 'cut' in front of other parents
- 3) The 'drive through' lane does not start until the preschool driveway
- 4) Parking is also available at St. Augustine Church and Margaret Azevedo Park there are designated paths from both directly to our school. We have a great relationship with St. Augustine. Their Pastor has asked that we not park in the spots immediately in front of the building so that their senior citizens always have close access.
