Why Odyssey of the Mind?

Odyssey of the Mind is an international creative problem-solving program that engages students in their learning by allowing their knowledge and ideas to come to life in an exciting, productive environment. Participants build self-confidence, develop life skills, create new friendships, and are able to recognize and explore their true potential. Odyssey of the Mind proves that students can have fun while they learn.

What does an Odyssey team do?

- 7 students make up a team to solve a "problem" which focuses on one of five problem categories: mechanical/vehicle, technical, classics, balsa structure, or performance
- Present their solution to their problem in an 8 minute solution at the Regional Tournament in March of 2020
- Winners advance to State Finals
- Works on teamwork, creative use of materials, problem solving skills, and out of the box thinking

Specifics:

- There will be two teams: Each team is made of seven members with one made of 4th-5th graders and one made of 6th-8th graders.
- Students must try-out. Tryouts will be **November 4th** for 6th, 7th, and 8th graders and **November 5th** for 4th and 5th graders after school in the Computer Lab. Sign-up sheets will be posted the week of October 21st.
- An informational meeting will be held for parents and students after school on **October 29th** in the Blue Room.
- Teams will be coached by Darlene Harper, Carol Royal, and Jennifer Solinsky
