Parking Lot Etiquette

From time to time I need to publish reminders about "parking lot etiquette." Please keep in mind that these rules are for everyone's safety, especially our students.

- o There is only <u>one</u> lane of traffic coming down our long driveway. Parents may use the left lane AFTER they have passed the preschool driveway.
- o The Preschool loop is not to be used to "cut" in front of other cars waiting. Preschool parents: To ensure safety, NO LEFT TURNS from the preschool dropoff area; please proceed through the parking lot as you exit.
- o If you see a "hole" in the loading/unloading zone, this does not mean that you can go around cars in front of you to get that spot. Please use common courtesy and wait your turn.
- o The right hand lane (closest to the curb) is the only lane that we will allow kids to get into / out of cars from. This is the pickup/drop off lane. You are never to leave your car unattended or parked in this lane. PLEASE DO NOT BLOCK CROSSWALKS!
- o The beginning of the right hand lane (for pickup purposes) is at our fire gate. Please do not park in front of this area as it impedes traffic flow and is considered a "red fire access" lane.
- o The left hand lane in the school parking lot is the drive through lane for parking purposes. For safety reasons, it is not the "hurry up and get in the car to bypass the long line" lane. Please use this lane if you are going to park your vehicle to drop off / pickup your child. Note: The church parking lot is available for MMCA parents during our school day or events at night.
- o There are two crosswalks for a reason, and we require everyone to use them. It's very important that the crosswalk is used, and please hold the hands of the little ones, as they are hard to see over the hoods of cars.
- o Please have your child load and unload from the passenger side of the car.
- o Do not, under any circumstances, allow your child to walk the path and load into your car in the upper driveway pick up line. The children can only load/unload from your car directly in front of the school.
- o We ask that you drive all the way up to the next car in the unloading/loading zone so that we can get more kids in and out of their cars. Teachers and parent volunteers will be on the sidewalk directing traffic during student pickup, so please follow their lead.
